Have your say on the future of environmental regulation in Queensland

Consultation is under way about the possible establishment of an independent Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for Queensland. The consultation seeks to understand the views and needs of the community and stakeholders about the future of environmental regulation in Queensland.

An EPA is an organisation responsible for environmental protection and regulation.

In Australia and around the world, there are different models for environmental regulators. One of the key elements of any model is to what level they are designed to ensure objectivity and integrity in decision-making – their level of independence.

The role of Queensland's environmental regulator is currently undertaken by the Queensland Government Department of Environment and Science (DES).

Contemporary, best practice regulation is constantly evolving and it is critical for current and future generations that the State's environmental regulator is positioned to deliver long-term, sustainable outcomes that meet community and industry expectations.

The community survey has nine questions and takes about five minutes to complete.

The survey is supported by a community summary publication, designed to help interested Queenslanders understand more about environmental regulation and the role of independence.

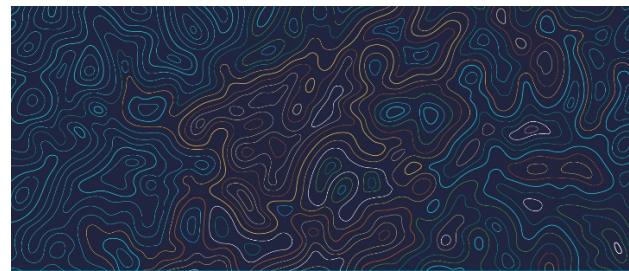

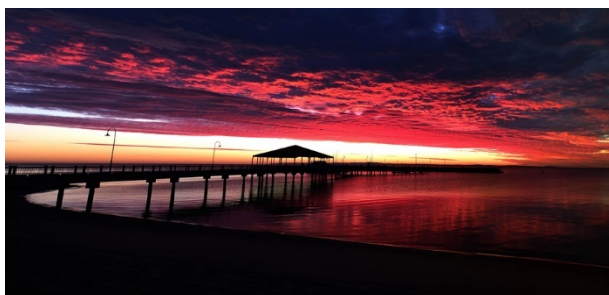

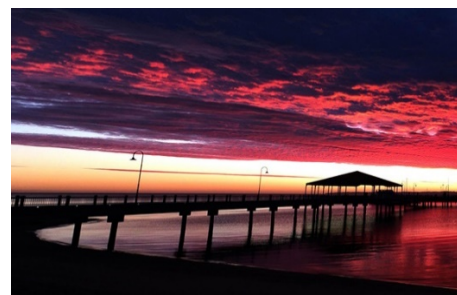
